- Potential D1 and/or D2 athletes should confirm the course meets NCAA requirements: https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/
- Core courses may be taken to remediate ( $=$ to fix) a $D$ or $F$ in a previously taken SMUSD course.
- Core courses may not be taken for advancement (for example: a 10 th grader taking 12 th grade English), however elective courses may be used for advancement.
- Minimum SMUSD graduation requirements must be completed at SMHS. SMHS will accept up to 30 outside credits to meet elective credits towards graduation requirements.
- SMHS does not endorse any outside institutions. SMHS cannot guarantee that outside courses cover the necessary curriculum to prepare students for the next level,
