Important tips:

- Use your personal email (not SMUSD). Check often!
- Check your portal for each CSU campus to which you apply. They will have "to do" lists and deadlines.

High School Coursework

- Can include A-G courses from grades 7 & 8 (Chinese 1, Spanish 1, Geometry, etc.)
- Entering grades:
Drop down of letter grades- use transcript (no + or -)
- Only need to include A-G courses (not PE, Weights, AFJROTC, etc.)
- Senior year courses:
First semester courses – mark **In Progress**
Second semester courses – mark **Planned**
- AP Government & AP Economics ONLY:
AP Gov't: mark **In Progress & No Grade**
AP Econ: mark **No Grade & Planned**

Honors & AP courses

- Only use Honors drop down if the honors or AP course has a * next to it on the transcript
- If there is no *, then mark **None**
- If course has a *, then mark **Honors**

- Only SMHS Honors courses that are marked Honors:
- Genetics Honors, Spanish 3H, French 3H, Philosophy/Sociology H, Wind Ensemble H, Intro. to Engineering Design H, Principles of Engineering H

Update A-G Courses

- Applicants must click on the Update A-G Courses button to review their entries, and ensure that all courses have an A-G area assigned
- Area G courses may be pulled from additional years completed in above A-F categories
 - Most applicants utilize the year of World History typically taken in 10th grade
- Based on the UC's revised Laboratory Science disciplines, applicants may need to manually revise the D1/D2 category

A-G Warning

- Should all subject areas not be met, applicants will see a warning message, displaying all areas where there are deficiencies
 - Applicants may accept the warning and move forward, or return to the A-G Matching Screen

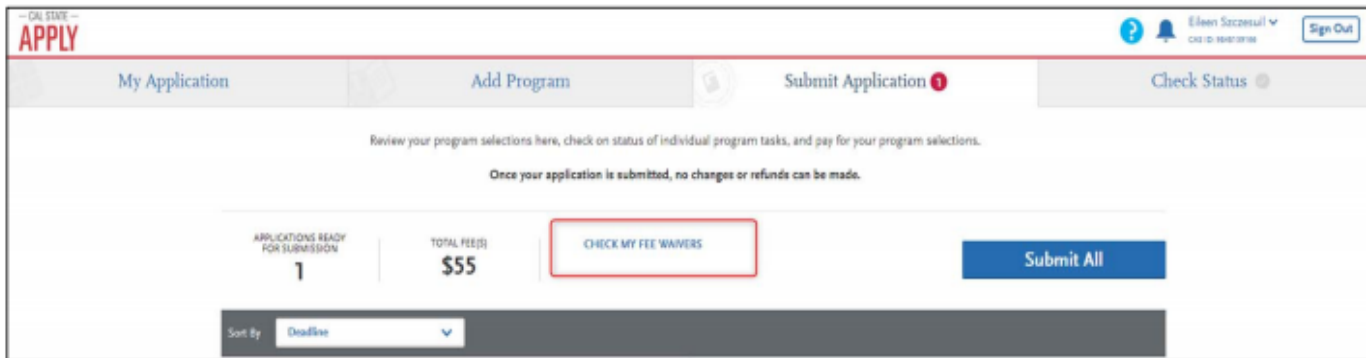

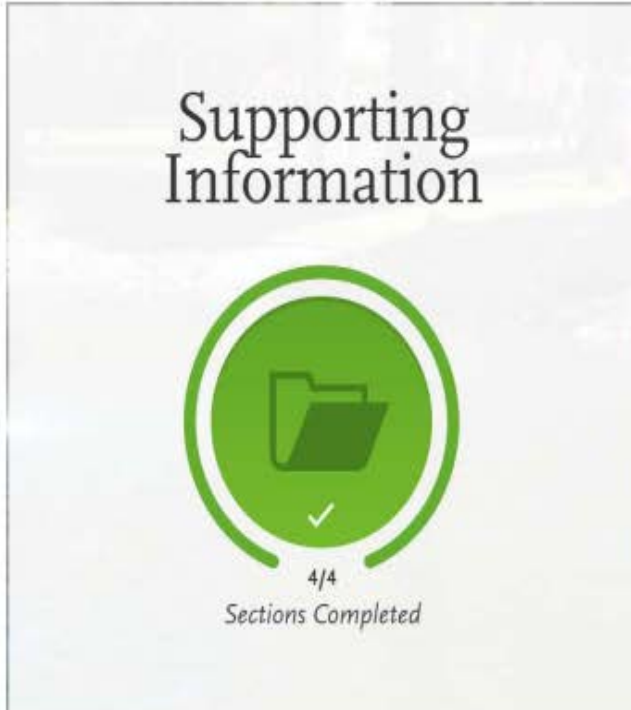

 - Scores will be shared with every campus to which an applicant submits an application
 - Applicants are encouraged to report their ACT ID

Live Chat

- Some CSU's are now asking for 7th semester transcripts. Do not send transcripts unless requested to do so by a specific campus.
- If you listed a course on your application and then drop it, or earn a D or F in any senior year courses, you **MUST** notify the admissions office at each university to which you applied.
- All acceptances are conditional; **MUST** earn C or better
- No letters of recommendation accepted by CSU (only for EOP program)

Repeated courses

- CSU defines repeated courses as the exact same course with the exact same course title taken at the same school at a later time.
- If you repeated a course, enter the highest grade(s) earned for the course.
- Do not enter this repeated course twice.
- If the repeated course is planned or in progress, enter the original grade earned since a new grade has not yet been earned.

Final Transcript Requests

- All processed through Parchment.
 - DO NOT USE your SMHS email.
 - Provide a personal email.
 - Request transcripts on the SMHS Counseling Website > Transcript Requests.

PACE Promise

- Have you been enrolled in the San Marcos Unified School District all 4 years?
- Have you completed the A-G coursework with grades of "C" or better?
- Did you meet the CSU eligibility index?
- Have you taken the SAT Reasoning or ACT Exam?
- You must submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Dream Act Application starting October 1st.

➤ PACE SCHOLAR

- For the \$1000/year, CSUSM must consider you college ready in math and English. Check your portal – they will tell you

YOU MUST SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO CSUSM

Eligibility Index

- Use your A-G GPA to compare it on the Eligibility Index. This is found on the A-G matching chart of your application
- A more detailed chart is in your CSU packet
- Must have minimum 2.0 A-G GPA to apply to CSU (this is eligibility, not admission minimum)
- See CSU packet for average GPAs and test scores for each CSU campus!
