### **SMHS** Graduation Requirements for Class of 2024

English	4 years (40 credits)
Math	3 years (30 credits) including one year of Geometry
Social Studies (History)	3 years (30 credits) 10th grade World History, 11th grade U.S. History, 12th grade Government
Science	2 years (20 credits) Life Science & Physical Science **pending board approval
World Language	<b>2 years</b> (20 credits) Can be satisfied with 1 year of a level 2 course (Successful completion of 10 credits of CTE may count for 1 year of World Language or VAPA)
VAPA	1 year (10 credits) (Successful completion of 10 credits of CTE may count for 1 year of World Language or VAPA)
Physical Education	2 years (20 credits)
Electives	Any area of study (60 credits)

Must earn a grade of "D" or better in all courses to receive credit





### In NEED Column:

- Should be 20 in English and Social Studies (talk to counselor if >20 credits)
- Make sure you select courses for junior year that align to the subject area credits still needed
- Total needed should be 120 or fewer.
- Electives = any course beyond minimum subject area requirements

### Please remember when choosing:

- PLEASE include alternate electives that you would want
  - There are popular courses that fill up quickly!
- o period is **NOT** guaranteed
- TA positions are limited to 10 credits (over all four years).
- Choose balance and don't overload yourself. Think of obligations outside of school.
- Minimum graduation requirements must be taken on the SMHS campus (ex: English 11, US History).
  - For classes taken off campus, (charter, Palomar College, etc. are applied as *elective* credits) please contact your school counselor for further information.
- Students are limited to 6 classes per day (unless enrolled in band or AFJROTC)

# Begin choosing classes



- Refer to worksheet- write in each required subject area and course requests as the counselor goes through each slide, you will also begin to enter in course requests on StudentVUE
- Consider A-G and graduation requirements
- Do not forget about BALANCE
- Pick elective alternates as many courses will fill quickly!
- Discuss your choices and rationale with parent/guardian at home.
