When is Graduation?

Wednesday, June 7th at 6:00 PM in our Stadium.

What time should Graduates arrive on the day of Graduation?

Students need to report to the outdoor basketball courts (*behind the gym*) by 4:30 PM.

 What time will the gates open up for parent/guardian/family seating in the Stadium?

4:30 PM.

How will we know which side our students walk in from?

Each year it rotates, but for this year's Class of 2023:

Home Stands Seats: Last Names: (A - TBD)

Visitor Stands Seats: Last Names:(TBD - Z)

(** Visitor/Home Alpha assignments will be solidified in May and posted on our website. Make sure to enter the correct gate for your seating!

How long is the Graduation Ceremony?

Typically 1 ½ hrs. Give yourself time to celebrate on the field after the ceremony and traffic for dinner reservations.

Gown Colors?

Our gowns are Blue unless a student has a GPA of 3.75 and above. The GPA is determined by the end of the second progress report of the second semester of the Senior year. If the student has a GPA of 3.75 or higher, based on the Honorary Distinction as stated above, then the student will wear a Silver gown. This is determined by the counseling office. Weighted grades do count. Mr. Dawson will email all students if they qualify in April.

• Gown Pick-up?

Gowns will be available for students to pick up on June 5th after 11 am. Graduates must pick up their own gowns in the Gym.

Handicap Seating /Parking?

Yes, it is limited and on a first-come, first-served basis in our front lot adjacent to the SMHS Theater.

How many tickets will each student get?

4 Tickets

• When will they get their tickets?

June 6th at their **mandatory** graduation practice, only students can pick up their tickets.

Kids ages 2 and under?

Do not need a ticket to get into the stadium.

• Parking for Graduation?

Because of our limited parking, we secure The Rock Church parking lot across the street. We also suggest carpooling or using Uber/Lyft.

How can I get more tickets?

Due to the size of our stadium, we are limited to <u>4 tickets</u> per student. PTO offers VIP/Auction and Raffle seating options. (**This is a fundraiser run through PTO and is in addition to the 4 tickets provided by the school. These seats are located on the track.)

No balloons or big signs are allowed into the Stadium!

Balloons, umbrellas, signs, and air horns/noise makers will be left at the entrance gate and not allowed in (i.e. *anything that would obstruct the view of others*)

Are Leis allowed?

After the ceremony only, and must be held during the ceremony by parents or guests. Pre-Order a Lei by calling D & M Wholesale and they will need to be picked up at D & M Wholesale. (Pre-Order deadline is May 20, 2023)

• Can we decorate our caps?

We do not allow students to wear decorated caps during the ceremony. However, students can purchase a 2nd cap or create a cap "top" out of cardboard, etc. for pictures before or after the ceremony.

Photographer on the field?

There will be a photographer vendor on the field taking up-close pictures of students receiving diplomas. Students will fill out a card prior to graduation for photograph proofs that will be emailed and may be purchased.

• Will the ceremony be live-streamed online? Can I come and watch it from the SMHS theater?

Yes. Yes - more information to come at the end of May regarding securing tickets for the theater live stream.

• What is the appropriate dress attire for Graduates?

Dresses, skirts, pants/slacks, dress shirts, closed-toe shoes, and low sandals are all acceptable. (*Shorts, jeans, flip flops, and heels higher than 1" are not acceptable.*) If graduates wear heels higher than 1" they will be required to wear flat shoes provided by the school. All graduates must wear a cap and gown.

What height of shoes can girls have?

No heels higher than 1". If graduates wear heels higher than 1" they will be required to wear flat shoes provided by the school.

• Can Graduates wear sneakers?

Dress-shoes are preferred, but Vans or nice tennis shoes are acceptable.

• If I am eligible for a graduation sash or cord (i.e. CSF, NHS, Honorable Contributions, AVID, Seal of Biliteracy, etc.) how do I get this?

Your program/club advisor will be sharing information regarding how you can access the sashes/cords earned prior to graduation. All sashes and cords students plan on wearing during the ceremony must be preapproved by SMHS Administration.
